Pizza Labels can be printed and placed on the outside of the pizza box, helping organize your pizza delivery orders. The Pizza labels contain important information for the delivery including the Customer's Name, Phone number, Address, City, State, Zip. It also prints the store number, Order number, Sub Total, Tax, Total, Box 1 of X.






Installing the Correct Label Printer Drivers

Note: To print pizza labels the label printer you are using will need to be installed using the **Generic/Text Only** driver. To install this driver (included in windows) please follow the steps below:


	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Select Start.
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Select Control Panel.
 <p>Printers and Faxes</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">2. Select Printers and Faxes.
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">2. Select Add a printer.
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Select Next.




4. Select **Local printer attached to this computer**.
 5. Select **Next**.
- Note:** Be sure to uncheck **Automatically detect and install my Plug and Play printer**.



6. Select **Use the following port:** then using the dropdown select the correct port:
 - If your label printer is plugged into a parallel port, select **LPT1**.
 - If it is plugged into a serial port, select the appropriate COM port.
7. Select **Next**.




8. Select **Generic** from the list on the left.
9. Select **Generic / Text Only** from the list on the right.
10. Select **Finish** completing the installation.




11. If you are asked whether you want to keep the existing driver or use the new one, select **Replace existing driver**.

12. Select **Next**.




13. Do not rename the printer or make it the default printer.

14. Select **Next**.




15. Select **Do not share this printer**.

17. Do not print a test page.


18. Select **Next**.



19. Select **Finish**.


Configuring your Label Printer to Print Pizza Labels

Start RPE, select **Manager**, provide the requested credentials, and follow these steps.


	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Select Setup and then Friendly Printer Setup.
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">2. Select Label under Select Friendly Printer.3. Select Generic/Text Only under Select Local Windows Printer.4. Under Printer Type use the dropdown to select the type of printer that you are using.5. When done select Save & Exit.


3. Each pizza you would like to print labels for must have **Print Delivery Labels** selected under the **Extra Info** tab.
- Note:** If the pizza has already been created select **Edit** then select the **Extra Info** tab and check **Print Delivery Labels**.
4. When finished select **Save** then select **Exit**.

Printing Pizza Labels for Delivery Orders

After the customer has placed the order we must then go into the delivery tracking screen where we can view the order and print the pizza labels.



1. After logging in, select **Delivery Tracking**.



2. The delivery order that was placed will show up on this screen.
3. If any order had a pizza item on it, you can highlight the order and select **Print Delivery Labels for Order**.
